## WHITE WINES

**JOURNEY'S END HAYSTACK Chardonnay 2010 - S. Africa \$ 58 \$ 252**

*Light yellow colour. Intensely-focused flavours showing citrus, tropical fruits and mineral tones. The taste is long and elegant with excellent fruit/wood integration. The palate shows riper fruit that combines well with the creaminess.*

**CLOUDY BAY Sauvignon Blanc 2010 – Marlborough, N. Zealand \$ 518**

*Scented and summery, the 2008 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc has deliciously vibrant aromatics that infuse the tropical fragrance of fresh passionfruit and juicy pineapples with garden-fresh basil and the spiciness of crushed tomato leaves. The palate is long and succulent, combining exotic fruits with ripe, red capsicum and a twist of green olive... beautifully complemented by crisp natural acidity and a hint of lime zest.*

**SHAW & SMITH Chardonnay 2008 - Australia \$ 548**

*This beautiful Adelaide Hills chardonnay gets better with each vintage. It's a gorgeously subtle white wine with a core of lemony fruit and just a hint of very smart, powdery oak. As good as new wave Aussie chardonnay gets.*

**DOMAINE LAROCHE Chablis Premier Cru Les Vaudevey 2006 - France \$ 798**

*Crystal clear with a touch of gold. Mineral, rich and very expressive flavours. A classical wine with aromas of flint stone and a subtle trace of butter. Crisp and abrupt in the mouth with a delicate, complexity and a substantial definite finish reminding us of the stony vineyards. Vaudevey is distinguished and refined when it is young, but develops an elegance, sharp and mineral with age. Lively and unctuous with a chiseled finish.*

**SPRINGFIELD ESTATE Special Cuvée Sauvignon Blanc 2009 - S. Africa \$ 388**

*Treated tenderly in the cellar with minimal intervention, the full expression of the terroir has been allowed, and the resultant complex, sensuous combination of passion fruit and flintiness gives a full mouthful with stylish length.*

**TERRAZAS Chardonnay Reserva 2010 – Argentina \$ 298**

*From Tupungato, this is a very good Chardonnay that offers aromas of pear, vanilla and toasted bread. It's almost Burgundian in style, with almond and white pepper accenting apple and mild citrus. The palate is crisp and refreshing with superb balance and a brisk acidity that carry the tropical fruit and honey dew notes through the pleasant finish.*

**BABICH BLACK LABEL Sauvignon Blanc 2010 - New Zealand \$ 298**

*Reminiscent of melon and tobacco flavors, with a clean finish. The bouquet is a pleasing assault of musk and passionfruit that leads into an intense fruit salad of flavours in the mouth. The sweet fruit combines perfectly with the zesty yet rich and textured palate. Notes of melon and gooseberry join the mid palate and linger on the finish.*

**VILLA CHIOPRIS Pinot Grigio IGT 2009 - Italy \$ 298**

*Straw yellow color with greenish reflections. The bouquet is intense with scents of wildflowers and lime. Medium-bodied with accentuated flavor of pear with good acidity and a fresh finish.*

## RED WINES

**CASA LA JOYA Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2009 - Chile \$ 58 \$ 252**

*Medium to deep red in colour with a purple edge. On the nose, the wine displays cassis/blackcurrant aromas with a touch of smoky oad. AA medium bodied wine with rich cassis flavours, velvety tannins and a chocolate persistence.*

**BROLIO Chianti Classico DOCG 2008 - Italy \$ 518**

*Bright ruby red with a generous and enveloping bouquet displaying hints of violets, ripe bilberries and spice. The palate is generous and soft, full and velvety. The finish is long and lingering.*

**EVANS & TATE Margaret River Shiraz 2009 - Australia \$ 508**

*Fragrant aromas of ripe black cherry and berry fruits, with savoury nuances, chocolate, and clove spice combined with toasted coconut oak aromas Partial barrel fermentation has added lift, and the oak is stylish and integrated.*

**SPRINGFIELD Whole Berry Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 - S. Africa \$ 488**

*Fermented uncrushed with natural yeasts, grapes harvested at full seed ripeness produce a velvety wine with softer tannins and classical varietal characteristics. This traditional wine is unfinned and unfiltered.*

**RUBIOLO Chianti Classico DOCG 2009 - Italy \$ 488**

*The wine is usually noted for its brilliant ruby-red color, which turns more garnet with age. It displays distinctive aromas of violets and rises in conjunction with wild berry notes, while the flavors are reminiscent of red and black cherries with a hint of earthy spiciness.*

**LA SIRENE DE GISCOURS 2006 - Margaux - France \$ 788**

*Beautiful color and brilliant cherry red. On the nose this wine shows aromas of red fruits, very ripe red with delicate spice notes. There is a very nice fresh flavor. On the palate, this wine opens fond tannins on the finish an elegant freshness.*

**CHATEAU DE SALES 1998 AOC - Pomerol - France \$ 1488**

*Its aromatic notes are intense and complex. On the palate it's creamy with fleshiness and richness: it has fullness and good balance with clearly perceptible, but not aggressive, tannins, due to the excellent ripeness of the grapes.*

**MITOLO SERPICO McLaren Vale Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 - Australia \$ 898**

*Vibrant purple color. Fragrant nose of blackcurrant, cassis and mulberry aromas with touch of cedar and spice. This opulent, rich and powerful Cabernet displays lush red and blackberry fruits complexes by chocolate, mocha and forest floor characters. The mid palate is powerful and concentrated with ripe, silky tannins.*

**FAUSTINO V Reserva 2004 - Rioja, Spain \$ 418**

*This Wine is medium to full bodied 90 - 95% Tempranillo grape giving richness and earthiness. This Fine scented strawberry fruits has one year cask ageing followed by two in the bottle before release.*

**ERRAZURIZ Max Reserva Merlot 2009 - Chile \$ 398**

*Beautifully layered complex aroma profile features red fruit like cherries, raspberries and strawberries, delicately decorated with hues of sweet spicy vanilla & cinnamon hinting of freshly baked cookies, raspberry tart & "crème brûlée". Gorgeous texture with vigorous yet elegant tannins, velvety caressing the palate & prolonging the flavours into a very pleasant, capturing & highly elegant finish.*

**TORBRECK Old Vines GSM 2008 Grenache, Shiraz, Mourvedre - Australia \$ 388**

*Deep garnet red with flickers of purple, the wines high-toned aromas of black cherries, five spice, crème de cassis and spring flowers. The palate offers a soft latent richness and silken-like texture with subtle notes of crushed cherries, doris plum and earth - all neatly wound by a taught spine of acidity and ripe supple tannins.*

**BABICH EAST COAST Pinot Noir 2009 - N. Zealand \$ 298**

*A soft and supple wine. Bouquet is a mix of sweet fruit - strawberry and plum, with savory forest floor notes. Berry fruit & earth are also found on the palate with a touch of spice, combining with finely textured tannins to produce a soft & supple wine.*

**TERRAZAS Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 2008 - Argentina \$ 298**

*Big and sassy with smoky aromas of BBQ meat, baked dark fruits, eucalyptus & leather. In the mouth, it's more sweet than subdued, with cassis, blackberry & hints of chocolate. Very much in the modern style, with a plush feel and theaftertaste of coffee meeting cola.*

**ZUCCARDI Q Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 - Argentina \$ 398**

*Deep ruby red color with purple hues, intense notes of red and black fruits with spicy aromas. It highlights black cherries, blackberry, black pepper and some eucalyptus. Voluptuous in the mouth, firm tannins and a complex long finish.*
